In the piano works of F. Liszt, the transcription genre took one of the central positions (с. 200). The Beethoven's symphonies, arranged for piano close to the original, were called by Liszt the "piano scores". Working on them had been going on for many years. This series, which includes Beethoven's Fifth Symphony in Liszt's transcription, is based on a publication edited by Portuguese pianist José Vianna da Motta.

It is addressed to students of music colleges and high schools, performing pianists.

В фортепианном творчестве Ф. Листа жанр транскрипции занял одну из центральных позиций (ок. 200). Симфонии Бетховена, переложенные для фортепиано близко к оригиналу, Лист называл «фортепианными партитурами». Работа над ними велась на протяжении многих лет. В основу настоящей серии, в которую входит Пятая симфония Бетховена в транскрипции Листа, положено издание под редакцией португальского пианиста Жозе Виана да Мотта.

Detailed description: This system shows the woodwind and piano accompaniment. The woodwinds (Flute, Oboe, and Clarinet) play a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes. The piano accompaniment features a bass line with eighth notes and chords. Pedal markings are present under the piano part. The dynamic is marked *sempre ff*. An *Archi* (strings) marking is also present.

Detailed description: This system shows the brass and string parts. The Horns and Clarinet play a rhythmic pattern. The Violins I and II play sustained notes. The dynamic is marked *ff* for the woodwinds and *p* for the strings. A *Ped.* marking is present under the piano part.

Detailed description: This system shows the Violin and Viola/Vcello parts. The Violins play a rhythmic pattern, and the Violas/Vcellos play sustained notes. The dynamic is marked *ff*.
